- Teams
- OneDrive
- Microsoft Office Suite
- Google Suite

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR APPLE DEVICES

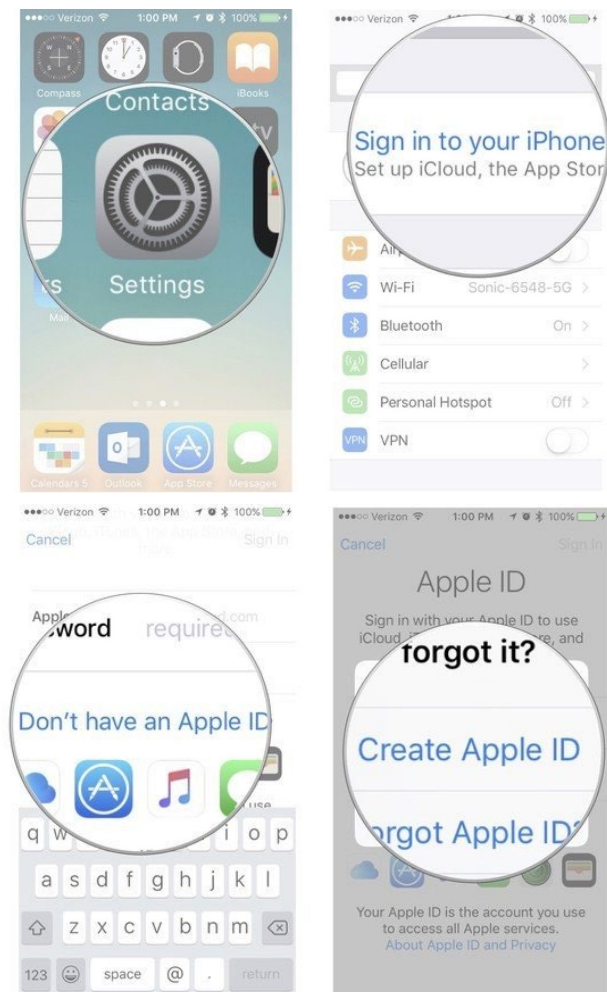


Apple devices come with an app called “App Store” that allows the user to search for apps and install them from within the app. In order to install apps from the app store, you must have an existing APPLE ID signed into iCloud.

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO CREATE A NEW APPLE ID ON YOUR IPHONE OR IPAD

(If you already have this completed, skip to Installing Apps from the App Store)

1. Launch the **Settings** app.
2. Tap **Sign into your iPhone** at the top of the screen.
3. Tap **Don't have an Apple ID or forgot it?**
4. Tap **Create Apple ID** when the window pops up.
5. Enter a **birth date**.
6. Tap **Next**.
7. Enter your **first and last name**.
8. Tap **Next**.
9. Select your current email address or get a new iCloud email address.
10. Enter your **email address**.
11. Create a **password**.
12. Verify the **password**.



13. Select **security questions** and input answers.
14. Agree to the **Terms and Conditions**.
15. Tap **Don't Merge**, or **Merge** if you are going to sync iCloud data from Safari, reminders, contacts, and calendars.
(You will most likely select Don't Merge. If you are unsure, select Don't Merge).
16. You're done! Continue to learn how to begin installing applications.
