Project SEARCH is a transition-to-work program that takes place entirely at MyMichigan Medical Center Sault. Interns receive hands-on training through 3 different internships based on the intern's interests and career goals.

Program Features

- A large variety of internship opportunities in almost **20 different departments**.
- Training in employment **skills** that can be **transferred** to any job.
- Assistance in finding **permanent, competitive** employment within your community.
- On-site staff including a **Special Education Instructor** and **Job Skills Trainers**.
- 1.5 hours of **daily** instruction on employment and life skills.
- Provided **transportation!**
- Provided **uniforms** and **shoes!**
- A daily **lunch** allowance!
- **Assistance** with work-place related accommodations and modifications.
